

**BYLAW NO. 3-2022**

**RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LONGLAKETON NO. 219**

**A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW 6-2013 KNOWN AS THE ZONING BYLAW**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Longlaketon No. 219, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enact to amend Bylaw No. 6-2013 as follows:

**1. Interpretation**

- 1) The following definition and table are to be included in subsections 8.6 and 9.6 for interpretation and reference:

Animal Unit – The kind and number of animals calculated in accordance with the following table:

Animal Type	Number of Animals = 1 Animal Unit

Rams and Ewes	7
Lambs	14
<b>Goats, Etc.</b>	
All (including llamas, alpacas, etc.)	7
<b>Cattle</b>

<b>Horses</b>	
Colts and Ponies	2
Other Horses	1

**2. Application**

- 1) The following subsections are amended to allow for changes to the keeping of livestock regulations:
- a) Subsection 8.6.9 is amended by deleting the existing table and replacing with the following:

12.67 acres and larger	Horses (no stallions); or Cattle (no bulls); or Sheep; or Goats	4 animal units; or 4 animal units; or 4 animal units; or 4 animal units
	AND  Poultry	25 hens & 1 rooster with the application of annual discretionary use permit

- 2) Subsection 9.6.17 is amended by deleting the existing table and replacing with the following:

12.67 acres and larger	Horses (no stallions); or Cattle (no bulls); or Sheep; or Goats	4 animal units; or 4 animal units; or 4 animal units; or 4 animal units
	AND  Poultry	25 hens & 1 rooster with the application of annual discretionary use permit

- 3) Subsections 8.6.10 and 9.6.18 are amended by replacing them with the following:
- Animals shall not be pastured within 15.25 metres (50 feet) of any dwelling or well not owned by the owner of the animals.
  - Manure shall be removed and responsibly discarded or composted on a regular basis.
  - Disposal of deceased animals shall be done in accordance with Ministry of Agriculture regulations.
  - Vacant lots cannot be pastured without council approval.
  - Prior to acquiring animals, it is recommended that interested individuals consult with their neighbours to identify and address any potential issues or conflicts.
- 4) The following shall be added as Subsections 8.6.11 and 9.6.19:

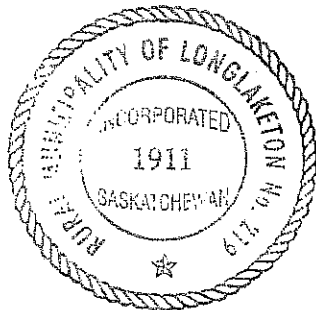
The keeping of poultry shall be permitted in accordance with the following conditions:


- A temporary development permit is applied for, and upon approval, reviewed annually for renewal.
- The site and coop shall be properly secured and maintained so as to deter predators and to limit excessive smells or noise.
- The sale of eggs on-site shall not be permitted without an application and approval for home-based business.
- All hens shall remain in the coop or an enclosed and secured run at all times.
- Chicken coops shall be located in the rear yard of a property or to not interfere with neighbours enjoyment of their own property.
- No coops or runs shall be located within 30.50 metres (100 feet) of an adjacent dwelling.


5) The following shall be added to Clause 3.29.8 as Subclause g):

The keeping of poultry in Country Residential Districts 1 and 2.


6) This bylaw shall come into force and take effect when approved by the Minister of Government Relations.
